#### **CALL FOR PROPOSALS: CONCURRENT SESSIONS**

This year's theme, ***Building Capacity for the Future*** will be a platform for furthering our discipline relative to specific subject matter areas, engaging students both within the classroom and in online learning platforms, as well as facilitating certificate and degree-seeking students' journeys toward CFP<sup>®</sup> certification. Subject matter experts and researchers are encouraged to submit proposals that focus on furthering the discipline and enriching current practice.

#### **Preference will be given to proposals that:**

- Facilitate students' pathways to CFP<sup>®</sup> certification
- Offer guidance and resources related to student assessment in financial planning education
- Illustrate effective avenues for preparing students to enter financial planning practice
- Offer guidance regarding engagement of adult learners in the classroom or learning platform
- Focus on student retention, incorporating avenues to encourage students to complete programs of study and obtain CFP<sup>®</sup> certification
- Introduce empirical research designed to enhance curriculum and instruction in financial planning education programs
- Emphasize integration and application of course content into real-world situations and scenarios
- Incorporate technology to enhance student achievement
- Offer instructional strategies suitable for certificate, baccalaureate, and graduate programs
- Incorporate cross-disciplinary instruction, utilizing faculty and research from an area of study traditionally outside of financial planning education

### Proposal Requirements

- A Title** for the proposed session.
- A Brief Description:** in less than 250 words, describe the content and topics to be addressed in the proposed session.
- Presenter Information:** provide the name, title and Registered Program affiliation(s) of each presenter/facilitator who will participate in the proposed session (Submissions for the Innovations Session do not have to include individuals who are affiliated with a CFP Board Registered Program).
- Principal Contact Person:** provide the principal contact's name, title, Registered Program affiliation(s), mailing address, phone, fax and email. Please note that the principal contact is responsible for informing all other panelists of session requirements, including date, time, length and participation/payment obligations at the Conference.
- Audiovisual Requirements:** provide details of any audiovisual resources required for the proposed session or discussion.
- Resource Materials:** identify the materials, if any, participants will be provided to take back to their institutions.
